#### 1.5 Jawaharlal Nehru College, Boko

#### 1.6 Amrit Prabha Ranger team

**Jawaharlal Nehru College Ranger Team, Boko** was formed on 21-01-2003 under the Bharat Scouts & Guides, Assam at Jawaharlal Nehru Collge, Boko, Kamrup (R), Assam. Although the Team registered as Jawaharlal Nehru College Ranger Team later it was named as '**Amrit Prabha Ranger Team**'.

**Amrit Prabha** was a daughter of **King Bala Varman of Varmana Dynasty**. The **Varmana Dynasty (350-650)** was the **first historical dynasty of the Kamrupa Kingdom**. It was established **Pushya Varmana** a Contemporary of **Samudragupta**. **Amrit Prabha** got married to a King of Kashmir **Meghavahana**, through a Sayambara. In Kashmir Amrit Prabha worked for **Buddhism, Literacy and Women**. So, we kept the name as **Amrit Prabha Ranger Team** so that our Rangers get inspired for the empowerment and doing something for the Society.

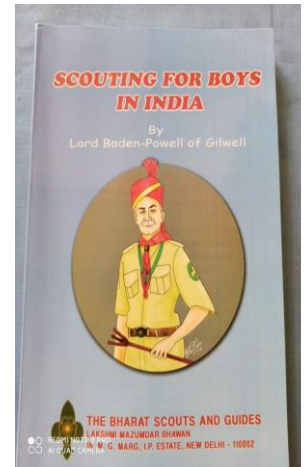


### 10. Offered Mask to DC and NE Regional HQ BSG (31-08-2020)

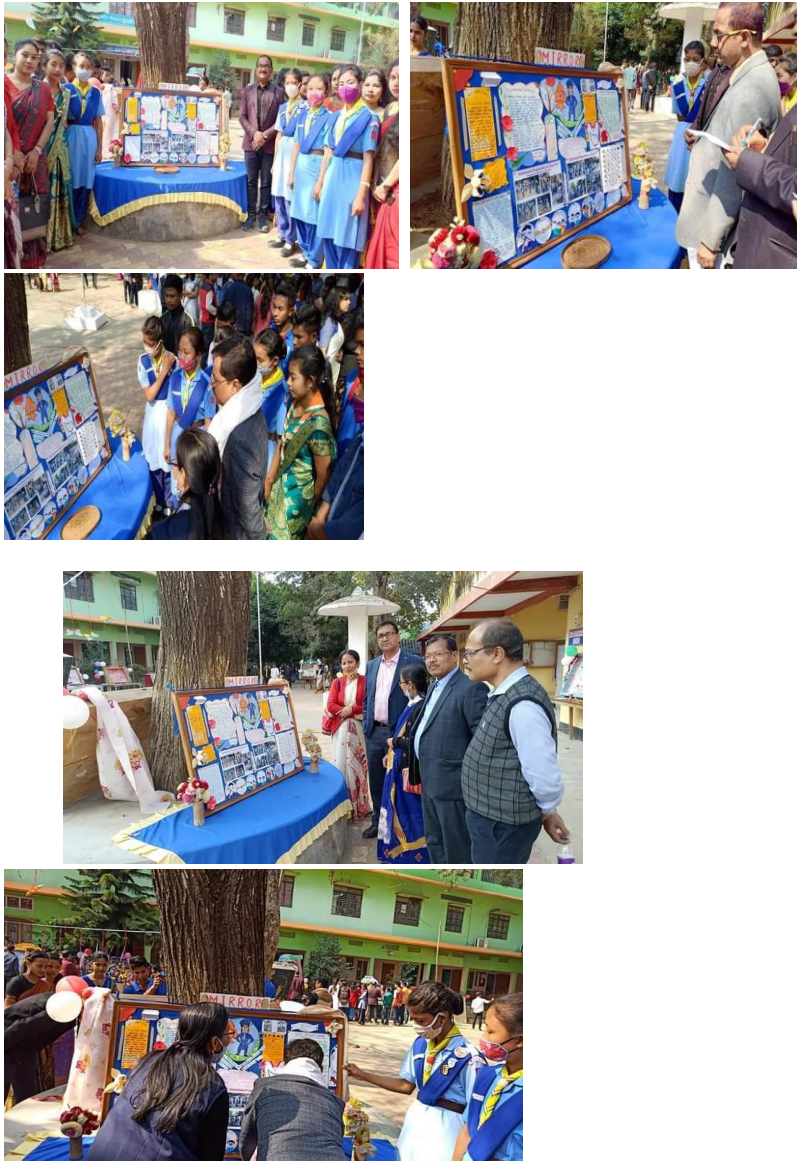
### 35. 'Mirror' (Wall Magazine Competition (06-02-2021) :

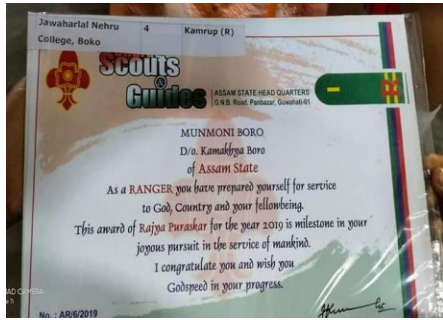
### **37. Rajya Puraskar Award (20-02-2021) :**
