So we prepared the mask from Gamosha, it is elastic fit i.e. it fits everyone with their facial feature.

We therefore try to give the message that we can easily make the mask at our home as precautionary message for Covid-19.

Poor people can also learn something during the crisis by selling it. As most other works are currently on hold.

The Team went door to door to create awareness among people on the importance of washing hand maintaining cleanliness during this Covid-19 situation.

Moreover the team donated dry food and fruits to the needy people




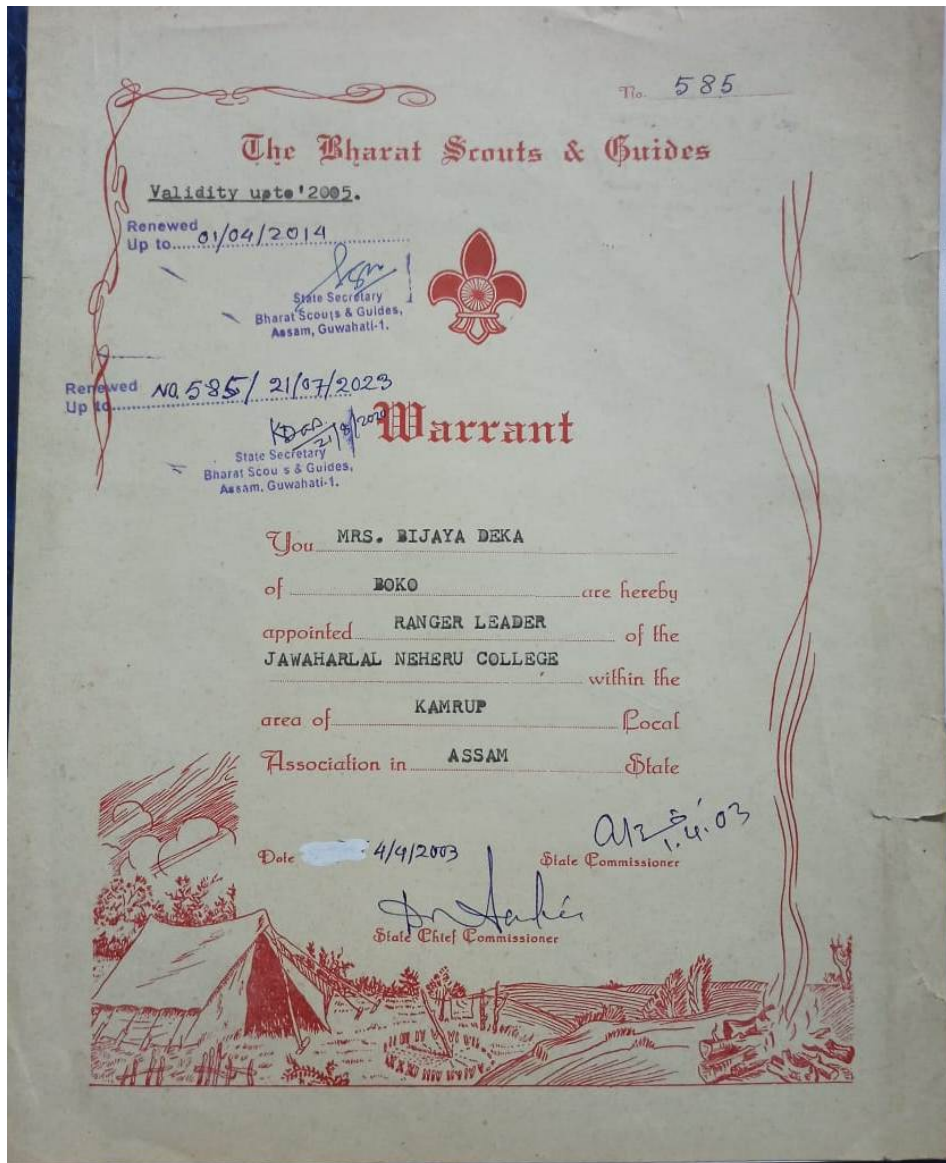
