Amrit Prabha was a daughter of King Bala Varman Dynasty. The Varmana Dynasty (350-650) was the first historical dynasty of the Kamrupa Kingdom. It was established Pushya Varmana a contemporary of Samudragupta. Amrit Prabha got married to a king of Kashmir Meghavahana, through a Sayambara. In Kashmir Amrit Prabha worked for Buddhism, Literacy and Women. So, we kept the name as Amrit Prabha Ranger Team so that our Rangers get inspired for the empowerment and doing something for the Society.

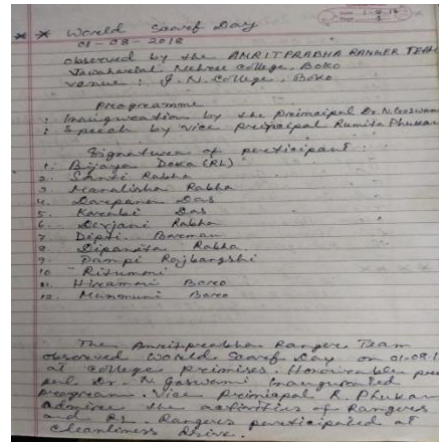
- (1) Character and intelligence

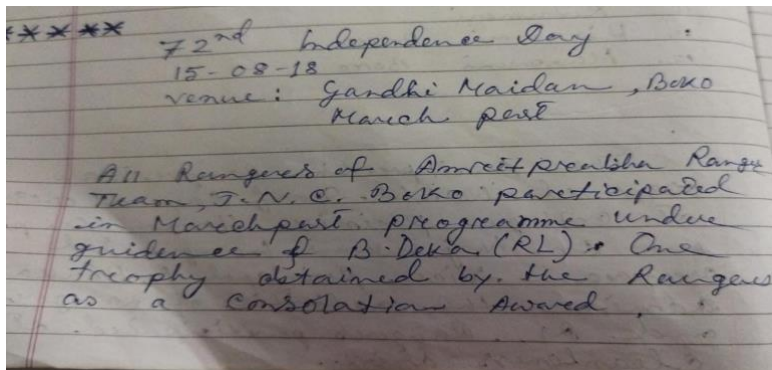
OBSERVED WORLD SCRFT DAY:

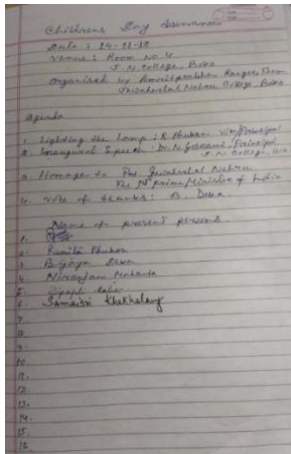
