Notes: The Assam government will observe September 22 as ‘Rhino Day’ to generate public awareness on protection of the one-horned pachyderm. It was officially declared at the 10th meeting of the State Board for Wildlife, which was chaired by Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal. The day will be exclusively dedicated to the approximately 2,500 rhino population in the state which would be a tribute to the rhinoceros, which are the “pride of Assam”. The state government will soon launch the State Rhino Project in line with National Rhino Project in Assam for protecting the pachyderms from threats of poaching.

6. India’s first cloned Assamese buffalo male calf ‘Sach-Gaurav’ has born in which state?

Notes: The Central Institute for Research on Buffaloes (CIRB) has claimed that India’s first cloned Assamese buffalo male calf ‘Sach-Gaurav’ has born in Hisar, Haryana on December 22, 2017. The calf was born to a Murrah buffalo through a normal delivery. It was also the first to be born in the field, 100 kms from the cloning laboratory at Hi Tech Sach Dairy Farm. The birth weight of the calf was 54.2 kgs and it was in good health. It had normal physiological parameters and blood profile. The genotype of the calf was confirmed by microsatellite analysis (parentage verification) and chromosome analysis. The Indian Council of Agricultural Research-CIRB is a central institute and it has a mandate to conserve superior animals of all buffalo breeds.

The katas, mundas and bandhas were the main irrigation sources in the ancient tribal kingdom of the Gonds (now in Odisha and Madhya Pradesh).

The entire border length touches Arunachal Pradesh (520 km), Nagaland (215 km), Manipur (398 km) and Mizoram (510 km). The India–Myanmar border has been frequently in news due to its porous nature and cross-border movement of militants and Rohingyas from Myanmar into India. Besides these, the border is also used for trade of illicit drugs, cannabis herbs, ganja and banned pseudoephedrine tablets. Recently, the governments of both the countries have decided to seal the 1643-km-long border.

It is a joint project between India and Nepal being executed under the 1996 Mahakali Treaty. Sawalkot Dam is a hydroelectric power project based on the Chenab River in Udhampur district of Jammu & Kashmir. The dam has been frequently in news for its high vulnerability to earthquakes and causing great disaster to Pakistan in future.
