The abstract should be written in English (Maximum 200 words) in Times New Roman font with single spacing between lines. The recommended font size is 14 pts for the title and 12 pts elsewhere. The main text should be justified. The abstract should include the title (14pt bold, centre), author(s) name (12pt italics, centre), affiliation, mailing address, telephone number, e- mail and clearly indicating the name of the author to whom correspondence should be made. Name of the author presenting the paper should be underlined. The soft copy in MS Word in ready to print form must be submitted via email attachment to: tapanjnc@gmail.com or pk12rabha@gmail.com .
