

Training programme on Ornamental Fish Culture for ST Women

A Training programme on Ornamental Fish culture for the ST Women of the locality was conducted at Aquaculture & Biodiversity Centre, Department of Zoology, Gauhati University on 3rd January, 2022. The main aim of this training is to promote self employment among the ST women. Prof. Dhandhar Sharma, Coordinator of the Aquaculture & Biodiversity Centre gave a lecture on indigenous ornamental fish species of Assam and North east India and its importance and future scope. He explained how indigenous ornamental fish species can be an alternative source for self employment for the people of Assam. He also demonstrated various methods of ornamental fish culture. The participant also observed the aquarium park, hatchery, rearing and stocking tank of the centre. The participant practically observed how Tubifex can be cultured which is the main fish food for ornamental fish species. The training programme was lead by teacher in-charge Mrs Nanda Devi and Dr. Rekha Chetry.
