Visit to Regional Sericulture Research Station, Boko

A Field trip to Regional Sericulture Research Station, Boko was organized by the Department of Zoology for B.Sc. 1st semester (Regular) students having Non Mulberry Sericulture as their SEC(Skill Enhancement Course) paper on 18th September, 2024. Dr. Rekha Chetry (HoD) and Dr. Susanta Kumar Bhuyan(Associate Professor, Department of Zoology) accompanied the students as teacher in- charge. Mr. Laben Hajong, Laboratory bearer was also in the team. In total 24 students took part in the field visit programme. Dr. S. A. S. Rahman, Director of the Station interacted with the students. Students during their visit learnt about the diverse aspects of Muga culture. They also observed the plantation of Som (*Persaea bombycina*) and Soalu(*Litsaea monopetala*), the two primary host plant of Muga silkworm. Students also had the opportunity to interact with Muga farmers on that day. The field visit was undertaken as our department had a MoU with RSRS (Boko) of Central Silk Board under the Ministry of Textile in the year 2023(6th March).
