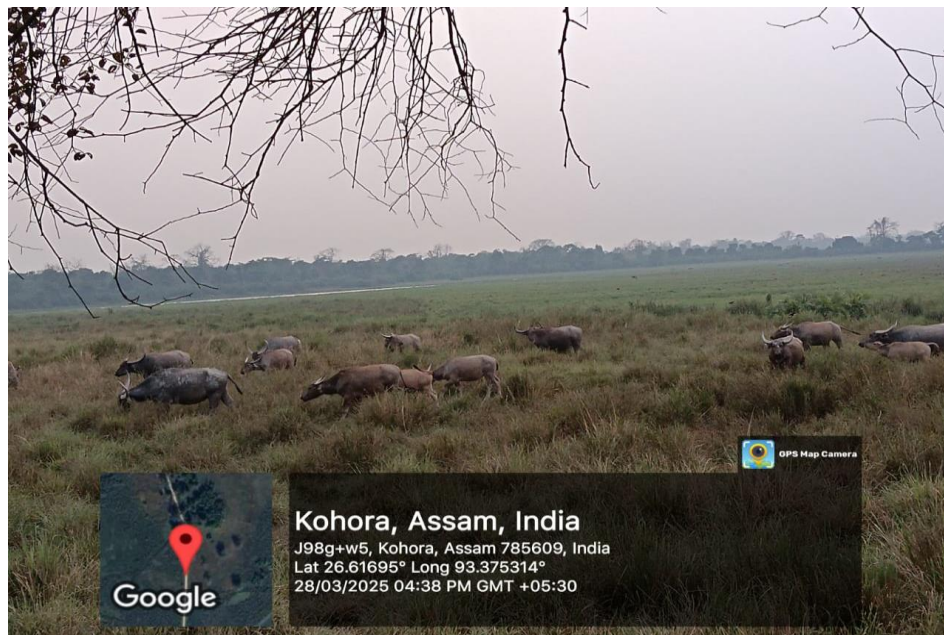

### **VISIT TO KAZIRANGA NATIONAL PARK:**

Department of Zoology carried out a field trip to Kaziranga National Park for the students of 4<sup>th</sup> Semester ( Major) on 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2025. This trip was basically organized for giving students the opportunity of experiential learning through field study. There were 23 students , 4 faculties namely Dr. Rekha Chetry(HoD), Dr. Susanta Kr. Bhuyan, Dr. Sangita Das and Ms. Abantika Bhagabaty and 1 lab bearer –Mr. Laben Hajong in the team. The team enjoyed the mandatory jeep safari in Kohora Range of the National park. Student sighted One horned Rhinoceros( *Rhinoceros unicornis*), Asiatic wild buffalos(*Bubalus bubalis*) , Indian Elephant(*Elephas maximus*),Sambar(*Cervus unicolor*), Swamp deer (*Cervus duvauceli*)and other wildlife during the safari. Students could observed the habitat of Rhinos and other grassland species . They could relate various theoretical aspects of ecology (viz. Population, Community, habitat, Interactions, density, diversity etc.) included in the Paper : (Principles of Ecology & Evolution : Code: ZLG0400304). On 29<sup>th</sup> they visited the orchid park where they observed various orchids species. For all the students this was the first exposure tour of their life.
