

FIELD VISIT TO POBITORA WILDLIFE SANCTUARY

A field visit to Pobitora Wildlife Sanctuary, Assam was organized by Department of Zoology of J. N. College, Boko on 25th April, 2026 for B.Sc. 4th semester students for experiential learning.
