Under the mission Amrit Sarovar with an objective of conserving water our college holds the privilege of developing one such large pond. Not only with an aim of fishery but for developing agro forestry work, the college is gradually developing the area with an aim of boosting self-sustained economy after the successful implementation of the Rubber Garden within college campus. The college is happy to announce that NECTAR supported a banana fibre processing unit and serve the purpose of solving unemployment problem in the locality and boost the economy. To promote Entrepreneurship college setup one EDC sponsored by IIE. It is a matter of pride for our college that under the Directorate of Cultural Affairs, Govt of Assam, a cultural centre for the promotion and sustenance of the rich and vibrant culture of the area, the Bishnu Jvoti Cultural Centre is already underway.

With the majority of enrolled students not being able to shine academically in their early education, excelled in their respective courses pursuing here under constant guidance and mentoring of teachers. This has definitely led to an excellent passing record and has brought laurels in all respect The results shown by the students of Jawaharlal Nehru College in the UG & PG final examinations are good in cosecutive years. Some students have shown very good performance in the National Level tests also. Mr. Nekib Ahmed, Mr. Devid Tamuli, Miss. Ani Rabha cleared JAM in Mathematics and Miss Nishashmita Bodo in Chemistry and they have qualified for admission for M.Sc. in IITs and NITs for this year.

In the CBCS UG programme, total 300 students appeared in the B.A. Final examination, of which 248 have successfully completed the final Examination and in B.Sc. Final Examination, total 123 appeared, of which100 have successfully completed their examination in 2023.
