21. Teaching methods adopted to improve student learning :

Teaching is confined to traditional lecturer method and use ITC tools. However, to improve students' learning process, periodic group discussion and seminars are arranged.

22. Participation in Institutional Social Responsibility (ISR) and Extension activities :

We have a departmental adopted village. Our faculty members go to adopted village and arranged student's motivation program for education, health care and checkup camp for villagers. Faculty members of the department sometimes participate in activities outside the college as part of programme in institutional social responsibility (ISR) and other extension activities. A faculty member of the department acted as master trainer on a number of occasions in the State Election Commission organized training programmes for polling officials and Census of the State.

23. SWOC analysis of the department and Future plans :

Sincerity devotion, punctuality and regularity of the teachers are the strengths and assets of the department. However lack of adequate number of permanent teaching faculties is the greatest weakness of the department. Therefore, the present faculties are constrained with additional responsibility to undertake their research activities. The adequate library and infrastructural facilities in the college have provided opportunities to both teachers and students to carry out their academic activities without any hindrance. However, lack of adequate faculties will loom large over the department as threat in the coming years.

Initiating research activities by the faculty members have been given paramount importance by the department. Organizing at least two national seminars and workshop and getting one minor research project will be in the priority areas of the department in the coming years.
