

Sessional Report

(2021-22)

In the session, 2021-22, the Department of Education completed the courses on time by taking regular classes as well as remedial classes. For continuous evaluation of the students, sessional tests, class tests were also conducted. In this session, the Department also organized 08 nos. of seminars and 02 nos. of workshops for the students, keeping in view some important topics from their syllabus. 01 no. of faculty exchange program was held.

The faculty members of the department undertake mentoring activities for each students in a continuous manner for bringing about overall development.

In this session, it was observed that 26 students appeared in the sixth semester final examination and 23 of them passed successfully. The pass percentage is 88.5%. It was seen that out of 26 students, 16 students acquired more than 70% and 07 students acquired more than 60% and the results of the remaining 03 students was not clear due to their arrear in the 1st semester final exam.

From the above results, we can opine that the achievement of the students are satisfactory.

It can be mentioned that though the achievement rate is satisfactory, but the progression rate to higher education is less due to non availability of adequate number of seats and also, some students are not interested for higher studies.
